TOURNAMENT HANDICAPS WHILE BACK 9 IS CLOSED

ACTIVE HANDICAPS – Will be updated after the last 18-hole tournament and will be frozen until 18-hole hole tournament play resumes.

EXISTING PROVISIONAL HANDICAPS (players with less than 6 posted rounds as of the closure date) – The expiration date for provisional handicaps less than 12 months old will be extended to match the duration of the back 9 closure. 9-hole tournament play will not be taken into account in converting provisional handicaps to active handicaps.

NEW PROVISIONAL HANDICAPS – New members (or those without a handicap) will be able to establish a 9-hole provisional handicap by submitting 3 scorecards from front 9 play using the existing procedure. When 18-hole play resumes, the Handicap Chair may convert them to 18-hole provisional handicaps at his discretion (based on rounds played during 9-hole tournament play) or require the player to re-establish an 18-hole provisional handicap by submitting 3 scorecards for 18-hole play. Alternatively, players with a GHIN index may choose to be assigned an 18-hole provisional handicap which will be valid when 18-hole tournament play resumes.
