

OHGC GENERAL MEETING

APRIL 16, 2026

Call to Order: 4:23 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance: Led by Mike Guillory.

Approval of Minutes: Bev Gillett moved to approve the minutes of the last meeting and Todd Albiston seconded. The motion was passed.

Welcome to new member, Joan Miller.

Treasurer's Report: Mary reported the Club has \$19,851 in the bank. This includes \$5,000 in sponsor money for Touring Amateurs and \$1,100 for Men's and Women's tournaments.

President's Report: Mike brought up the importance of not crossing the red line around the lake for personal safety concerns.

OLD BUSINESS: Mike reported construction is nearing completion on the lake. The Master Board approved money for O'Connell to buy sod and for irrigation work. A large boulder also needs removal. It is now estimated the full course will be open for play sometime in June. There is no set date for the Grand Opening Tournament.

NEW BUSINESS: Mike and Alan led a discussion explaining handicaps and transitioning them from Golf Genius to Unknown Golf. Handicaps have been

frozen for a year. Unknown Golf handicaps are being processed and after six rounds of play, the handicaps will become active. Updated handicaps are not posted yet. Unknown Golf can be used for Ocean Hills rounds as well as for outside play, but scoring and handicapping are separate systems. After the full course is up and running, training will be provided in the use of Unknown Golf, including live scoring. Golf Genius and Unknown Golf will continue to be utilized for now; however, Niners and Fling Golf are solely using Unknown Golf with active handicaps. Unknown Golf was used for the recent Guys and Dolls and Touring Amateurs Tournaments. Alan noted there are some problems with members receiving emails that contain links. He suggested adding Unknown Golf to address books.

A concern was stated regarding ads received from Unknown Golf. Mike will check with Unknown Golf to see if it is possible to opt out of ads by resetting. Unsubscribing will result in closure of your membership and requiring members to re-sign into the website. He does not advocate paying for the upgrade at this time.

June 18 is the Summer Party with a Hawaiian theme. Terry has a signup sheet for volunteers to help with the party.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Membership: Tom reports we have 622 paid members. Women total 299 and Men 323. There have been 118 new members since October 1. Fling members total 135. Payments by credit card have increased to 67% and by check have decreased to 33% this year. This is improved from last year at 50-50. It is greatly appreciated. A reminder the membership due date has changed this year from October 1 to December 1.

Women's Golf: Debbie reported on the April Fool's Tournament. It was fun and well received. Thank you to Gay Spencer, Event Chair for Ladies' Golf, for all her work in making the tournaments successful. "Mama Jama," the Mother's Day tournament is coming up. Thank you to our starters Mike Brady,

Randy Royter, Alan Colson, Frank Cannon and John Drace. Long-time starter, Bernie Alfonso, will be coming back occasionally to help.

Debbie reported there are still issues to work out between Golf Genius and Unknown Golf and Ladies' Golf will continue to use both systems until the full course is open.

Men's Golf: Todd thanked his help with Monday and Tuesday Golf, including his starters, Ted Mitchell who coordinates the starters and the ladies who stuff the money envelopes. A Father's Day Scramble Shotgun Tournament is being planned if the full course is available. Todd will also continue with Golf Genius and Unknown Golf due to challenges with tee sheets, handicaps, rotations and scoring. Men's Golf will transition when ready.

Touring Amateurs: Mike reported the Touring Amateurs Tournament had rain which resulted in cart path only conditions. Four teams did not finish. Contracts state that unless the course closes, we are obligated to pay the entire fee. This will be the last year Mike and Annette will run the Touring Amateurs due to time constraints. New leaders need to step up to keep the tournament going.

Fling Golf: Don reported that Fling Friday continues with casual play and free training. Seven Fling Wednesday tournaments have been held with cash awards. Fling Fest Friday, "Fling and Swing" tournaments, continue on the last Friday of each month. A team consists of one flinger and one regular golfer. This is a scramble format with an entry fee and prize money awarded. "Touring Flingers" have played their first away game at the Executive Course at Lake San Marcos.
