

Addendum Minutes to December 5, 2025 Golf Club Board of Directors Vote

The resignation of Jerry Moskovitz in August as Handicap Chair led to a search for a new chair. Over nine people offered to take the position, but when they were shown how complicated the system was to operate, they all declined. The BoD then considered the option of having all tournament players obtain USGA handicaps. This was debated and because only 20% of our players have USGA handicaps, the board decided that we could not force our members to pay over \$40.00 a year for this option. Alan Colson, the interim handicap chair, was asked to search for an alternative way to run our handicaps. Over the ensuing months Alan streamlined the existing process and researched our options. He found a Golf Genius competitor, Unknown Golf. Unknown Golf, unlike Golf Genius, had a community scoring feature and central roster management that would allow us to compute our own handicaps in a very simple manner. Alan, along with Mike and Annette Guillory, participated in a couple of online tutorials and then obtained a 30-day free trial period of the software. During the trial period, the Men and Women's Golf Chairs and those assisting them with running the tournaments were shown how the system works.

On December 5, 2025, by email vote, the Board of Directors approved with 8 in favor and one abstaining, the purchase of Unknown Golf for 13 months for \$2,400.
