

OHGC BOARD MEETING

JULY 11, 2026

Call to Order: 9:00 AM.

Approval of Minutes: Tom moved to approve the minutes of the last meeting with a second from Kathleen. The motion was passed.

Treasurer's Report: Mike reported in Mary's absence the Club has extra money. This makes an extra \$700 available for the Member Appreciation Party, \$100 available for each of the remaining General Meetings and \$600 available for Social Mixers and FlingGolf.

President's Report: Mike reported a change to be made on the back of the next set of scorecards ordered. The local rule regarding a ball lost or out-of-bounds will be changed to read "Local Rule: For tournament play, all red-staked and white-staked (out-of-bounds) areas of the golf course are treated as Red Penalty Area/No Play Zones. A ball that comes to rest in one of these areas cannot be played as it lies. All players must take a one-stroke penalty and drop the ball outside the penalty area."

OLD BUSINESS:

Unknown Golf Transition: A lengthy discussion was held regarding the pros and cons of continuing with Unknown Golf versus going back to Golf Genius.

The scorers are still having difficulties each week and have complaints and questions from members. Alan feels Unknown Golf is working well and he is continuing to work on specific concerns and stresses more training is needed for scorers and members.

Kathleen requested a Board vote seconded by Mark as to whether to stay with Unknown Golf or return to Golf Genius. Of the eight Directors present, the vote was a tie and the motion did not pass. The Club will stay with Unknown Golf with more training and this issue can be revisited at the end of the year.

A discussion was also held on handicaps which have been frozen. Mike made a motion seconded by Tom to inform the members at the General Meeting that there will be a one-time handicap update made, date to be decided, to all members. This will sync handicaps within all our tournaments. The motion passed.

Back Nine Opening & Grand Opening Tournament: The opening of the full course is still unknown and the Grand Opening Tournament is still on hold.

Minimum Rounds for Active Handicap: It was noted there are many members that play very infrequently. It was agreed to send an email to all members that six rounds must be played in three months to establish and keep a handicap. If players fail to do this, they will stay on as club members but will not have an active handicap for tournaments.

OHGC Rules & Procedure: Mike reported the Rules & Procedures document is all one large file. He proposed breaking it down into separate files such as Charter, By-Laws, etc. It was agreed upon.

NEW BUSINESS:

Club Officer Nominating Committee: The Nominating Committee, now comprised of Mike and Annette, are looking for a third member. The committee will be seeking interested candidates to fill any open Board positions. An email will be sent to the membership regarding upcoming Board member elections, and anyone interested in running for a Board position needs to make their interest known.

Hitting Cage Mats – Mike: The hitting cage mats are in need of replacement as well as some work done to the cage area. As to who will pay for this is in question. If the Golf Club needs to pay for this, a fundraiser within the Club has been suggested.

2027 Calendar Scheduling – Kathleen: Kathleen will be handling the 2027 calendar scheduling and needs the Chairpersons' input by August 15.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Membership – Tom Vaccaro: Tom reported we have 648 paid members. This includes 310 women and 338 men. There have been 145 new members since October 1. Payment by credit card has been 67% and by check 33%. At the upcoming General Meeting, Tom will remind the membership that December 1 is the new signup date.

Women's Golf – Debbie Machnick: Debbie reported there have been an increase of Wednesday players to around 90. At the upcoming General Meeting, Debbie will thank and recognize the five starters with a certificate for a free round of golf for use on any Monday or Tuesday.

Men's Golf – Todd Albiston: Nothing to report.

Touring Amateurs – Mike Guillory, Annette Guillory: The next Touring Amateurs Tournament is scheduled on Monday, July 13, at The Links. Mike and Annette have announced their decision to stop running these tournaments next year and no one has stepped up to take over. Most likely, the Club will return to having Special Tournaments in the absence of Touring Amateurs.

Guys & Dolls – Mark Deutman, Teresa Deutman: The next Guys & Dolls Tournament is set for July 18. There are already over 120 players signed up.

FlingGolf – Don Quigley: FlingGolf continues with play following Women's Golf on Wednesday afternoon. Friday play is casual with training available. Once per month Don arranges Touring Flingers, a casual event. FlingFest continues on the last Friday of the month. This is a scramble event with one

Flinger and one golfer paired. There are usually 20-30 players. Don is considering a fun Friday challenge having Flingers vs. Golfers.

Teresa suggested the Golf Club have a sign to be put out during all tournaments stating the last tee time of the group as a consideration to the golfing public.

Golf Course Committee – Mark Deutman: Mark reported the concerns over new mats as they also need to be anchored and leveled. The oncourse restroom locks are being replaced with the same as the lanai restrooms. Civic twilight for closing times are noted on the website.

Handicaps – Alan Colson, Annette Guillory: Discussed earlier.

Niners - Mike Bell: Mike reports Unknown Golf is being used and working well. He noted he has had an average of 30 players, down from 40 players noted at the last meeting, possibly due to summer and vacations.

OHGC Website – Jim Kaminsky: Jim reports no problems with the website.

Holes-in-One – Larry McBride: Larry noted there are only 3 winners this period making additional pizza servers needed for the General Meeting. Terry has volunteer helpers she can ask to help.

Casa Facilities – Sue Cooke: Sue is still seeing 6-8 golf clubs in the casa each week.

Sunshine – Sue Bourland: Via email, Sue reports she has sent 13 cards this year. She requests Board members let her know if they become aware of someone needing a card sent.

Publicity – Teresa Deutman: Teresa's article in the July issue of OHCC Living spotlighted Touring Amateurs and included an interesting segment on Barbara and David Demerest, long-time residents and golfers with years of service to OHGC. Next month she plans an article on the youngest and the oldest golf groups in our community. Our golfers range in age from 50 – 90 years of age.

Hospitality – Terry Chamberlin: Terry reported the Aloha Party went over well but noted there were too many people for the Hall. Future parties may need to be capped. No date for the Grand Opening or Club Championship parties as of now. The Volunteer Appreciation Party is October 29. Please give a list of all your volunteers to Terry.
